

# BAY AREA SOCCER LEAGUE

Meeting Minutes  
Sunday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010

## **Opening:**

The regular meeting of the Bay Area Soccer League was called to order at 3pm on February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at Max & Erma's in Sandusky by Les Wilson, President of the League.

## **Present:**

### **A. Approval of Agenda**

The agenda was distributed by Les Wilson, President of the League, to the attending board members.

### **B. Approval of Minutes**

The minutes of the previous meeting were not taken, due to the vacant board secretary position.

### **C. Old Business**

A total of \$8086.90 was spent to purchase 5 complete sets of goals; they have been ordered and are expected to be delivered sometime in March. Les ordered 4 – 8'x24', 4 – 7'x21', and 2 – 6'x18'; they will come complete with nets and back bars. That total breaks down into the following, \$5950.00 was donated to BASL through the Wightman-Wieber Foundation through grant funding and \$2136.90 was paid out by BASL.

A donation check in the amount of \$1521.00 was given to the Erie MetroParks. \$1500.00 is our donation and \$21.00 is the percentage given to the park for concessions.

BASL's recreation program is now giving a multi-child discount. \$30.00 for the 1<sup>st</sup> child, \$55.00 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> child, and \$75.00 is the maximum you would pay for 3 or more children. A \$2.50 fee is charged when registering a child online through LeagueOne.

### **D. New Business**

Alyson Wilson was nominated to fill the vacant BASL board secretary position. Alyson accepted the nomination. There were no other nominations, the board vote was unanimous. Alyson Wilson has been elected to a 2 year term as secretary of BASL.

Registration Day will be Saturday, March 13<sup>th</sup>, 2010 from 8:30am to 11:30am at the Frost Center, located out at Osborn Park. Registration deadline is March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

Flyers for the Spring Season were discussed, with 5000 copies needed to pass out to Sandusky, Perkins, Huron, and Berlin-Milan Elementary and Junior High Schools. Katrina Scroggy agreed to create the flyers and check area printers for best price on printing.

Ads were discussed to advertise the Spring Season in the media. Alyson Wilson is going to contact the Sandusky Register and have both a free ad placed in the sports section and several paid ads in the local section. Katrina Scroggy is going to contact Buckeye CableSystem, regarding the Weathercrawl ad on channel 51, The

Weather Channel. Katrina will also contact 102.7, K96.1 and 100.9 radio stations and get our registration information placed on their community calendars.

NOGSL is looking for a place for their tournament in August 2010. Steve Schuster was going to check into this at his meeting with NOGSL and will have more information at our next meeting.

Discussed an incentive for all recreational coaches, tabled until the Fall season.

More volunteers and board members are needed. We are going to need help this season with field maintenance and concessions. Scholarship parents will need to step up and become more active. We are getting new goals, and will need assistance in moving them onto the fields. Scott Scroggy was going to contact the Erie County Sheriff's Office and see if it was possible to have trustees help with Sheriff's supervision.

For the Spring 2010 season, we will once again have a skills day for the U10 age group and a tournament for the U12 age group. Approximately \$500.00 will be needed to purchase medals and trophies. Katrina Scroggy is going to speak to a member of the Sandusky Kiwanis and see if they would be interested in sponsoring.

February 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010 is the planning meeting with the Erie MetroParks. It will be held at 7pm at the Maple Grove Center on Hull Road. Les Wilson will be attending to confirm our schedules and new field layout plans. It was suggested that several board members should attend, to prevent any future conflicts with other organizations.

Purchasing new equipment was discussed. We are in need of reversible goalie vests and flags. Les Wilson was going to check around for prices.

#### **E. Agenda for Next Meeting**

Les Wilson, President of the League, will establish the agenda for the next meeting.
